Camp Catch A Critter w/Lauren

In this class we'll hunt for bugs and beyond in Bixby's backyard (Including the Bridgeway and Tantra Park areas). We will learn how to sneak up on a resting frog, swoop through the air to catch super fast flying insects, and which rocks to look under to find small creatures. We'll learn how to handle the small animals we catch like scientists as we keep them for the day to learn about the helpful roles these small animals play in our world. When we're through studying them, we'll release them back into their habitat.

This session will be led by Lauren Augusta, Bixby kindergarten teacher, who has taught science classes for Wild Bear Center for Nature Discovery, The Smithsonian Natural Resource Center, Rocky Mountain National Park, and the Butterfly Pavilion.
