

# CIT Program

The Counselor in Training Program is open to rising 7th-9th grade campers. CIT's meet with the summer camp director on their first day and are assigned to a department based on their interest. CIT's work in a department alongside a Lead Teacher to gain leadership skills and experience working with children. During unit times, CIT's are with our youngest campers.

CIT's also participate in all camp activities such as the ramble, free time, and special camp programming.

## CIT Qualifications

To be able to participate in the CIT program, campers must be entering 7th-9th grade and also have been a camper at Bixby Summer Camp for at least 3 sessions. Campers are invited to participate in the CIT program if they demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Able to listen and follow directions
- Demonstrated leadership skills and willingness to grow in that role
- Remain calm under pressure
- Shows flexibility with changes
- Serves as a positive role model to other students in camp

## Dates and Prices

The CIT program follows the same session schedule as the K-9th program. Campers register and pay the full camp registration fee, but receive a stipend of \$10/day for each day that they attend camp. Stipends are paid out on the last day of the session.
