Welcome to August! Although the first day of school is still a month away, we wanted to preview for you some important information about the 2022-23 school year. Please read this email in its entirety.

The K-5 School Day will end at 2:30 pm every Wednesday this school year

This change to our schedule is an important investment of that most precious resource - time - for our faculty to plan, collaborate and grow. We have some exciting things planned for the year ahead and in order to do them well, we need time to reflect, refine and prepare. We recognize that this change may create a burden for families, and appreciate your support of our faculty. In order to ease the impact of this change on families aftercare will be available earlier on Wednesdays:

- 2:30 pm: Kindergarten-5th Grade classes end
- 2:45 pm: Any K-5 students still at school will be checked into our after-care program
- 3:00 pm: Drop-in charges will start to accrue (\$18 per hour, billed in 30 min increments).
 - $_{\odot}$ There is a grace period between 2:45-3:00 pm when no charges will accrue
 - o Families enrolled in our full-day program will not incur any additional charges
